

■ Interactive Checklist: Adobe Dreamweaver CS5 Key Website Creation

1. Installation and Activation

- ■ Check system requirements (RAM, OS, graphics)
- ■ Download and run installer from official source
- ■ Enter adobe dreamweaver cs5 key during activation
- ■ Disable firewall if activation fails
- ■ Run installer as administrator
- ■ Test program launch (fix if dreamweaver does not start)

2. Fast Website Layout

- ■ Define a new site before starting project
- ■ Create a new HTML file in Dreamweaver
- ■ Insert layout structure (div containers)
- ■ Add text, images, and media to page
- ■ Use CSS Designer to style elements
- ■ Save and organize files in project folder

3. Working with Templates and Forms

- ■ Build a template with header, footer, and navigation
- ■ Mark editable regions for content areas
- ■ Save template as .dwt file
- ■ Create a new page based on template
- ■ Insert a form (text field, textarea, email, button)
- ■ Set form action and method (POST)
- ■ Test forms on live server

4. Exporting and Uploading to Hosting

- ■ Use “Check Links Sitewide” to find errors
- ■ Preview site in multiple browsers
- ■ Open Manage Sites → Servers → Add FTP details
- ■ Test connection to hosting provider
- ■ Upload files with “Put” in Files panel
- ■ Ensure index.html is uploaded correctly
- ■ Synchronize future changes instead of re-uploading all files

■ Pro Tips

- Always keep a backup of your dreamweaver cs5 key and project files.
- Use Synchronize to save time and avoid version errors.
- Templates + CSS = consistent and professional look.
- If dreamweaver does not start, reset preferences or reinstall.
